Research & Development Request

A group of 3 Spanish complementary partners (a University, an engineering company and an architectural firm, all of them specialised in energy efficiency in building) is willing to submit a proposal to H2020-EE-4-2016 call : Standardised installation packages for the integration of multi-components (hybrid) renewable and energy efficiency solutions including thermal **energy storage** into buildings.

The group seeks companies or R&D institutions experienced in this field to complete the consortium. The consortium is expected to be integrated by around 6 to 8 partners in total.

Technical Specification or Expertise Sought :

- A manufacturer of HVAC systems based on renewable and low carbon sources
- A manufacturer of heat exchangers able to integrate PCMs
- An expert in the control of the HVAC system
- A R&D institution with know-how in the field of energy efficiency and certification processes (able to play as well the role of coordinator).

CleanSky: the third call to Core Partners is published

The Core Partners that will be selected are strategic CleanSky 2 members for 7 years.

Partners can apply alone or in consortium. There is no need to have multiple country depositors.

The challenge is to be integrated in R & D in the long term (7 years) in the supply chain of major contractors aircraft orders. This is an important opportunity in the context of the drastic reduction of the budgets of classic aviation H2020 calls.

The core partners retained in one of the 6 CleanSky platform can not participate in all future CleanSky calls.

Some examples of topics:

- Large passenger aircrafts IAPD
- Airframe ITD
- Systems ITD
- Fast Rotorcraft IAPD

The budget is € 95.9 million. It covers 22 topics.

The deadline is set for **February 4th, 2016**.

To build a competitive project, it is necessary to analyze the call and join the consortium as soon as possible, before December.

Horizon 2020 : 2016 - 2017 "SPACE" drafts have been published

Space research is supported in Horizon 2020 under the priority "Industrial Leadership", in line with the main objective and challenge to ensure that space will remain accessible to Europe and safe to operate in the long run.

Examples of calls :

- **Earth Observation** (with evolutions of Copernicus services)
- **Competitiveness of European Space Sector** : technology and Science
- **Applications in Satellite Navigation** - Galileo 2017

Horizon 2020 also plans other actions such as :

- Engineering support by ESA
- Space surveillance and tracking (SST)
- Studies and Communication

For 2016 calls, the first deadlines are set for **March 3rd, 2016**.





INTERNATIONAL TECHNOLOGICAL PARTNERSHIPS

Launch of a twinning call EU-Canada

The ERA-CAN + project has launched a first Twinning call for proposals on October 1st 2015.

The principle of this program is to foster collaboration between existing scientific projects in Europe and Canada.

Each Twinning project must take the form of a consortium funded by the FP7 (the Seventh Framework Programme) or Horizon 2020, and a team funded in Canada (federal or provincial).



The objective of the Twinning project is to promote sustainable collaborations and strategic actions between European and Canadian communities of Research and Innovation.

The maximum amount per application is €6,000. This amount is intended to cover in particular: study visits; organizing workshops and conferences; the exchange of data, information, knowledge or materials.

All cooperation themes are eligible, but applications focused on aeronautics, space, marine and Arctic research, health, ICT, food security and sustainable agriculture will be prioritized.
